66% College graduates with a bachelor's degree typically earn 66 percent more than those with only a high school diploma and are also far less likely to face unemployment.

35% of San Antonio residents hold a college degree, compared to the national average of 47%.

\$1M

Over the course of a lifetime, the average worker with a bachelor's degree will earn approximately \$1 million more than a worker without a postsecondary education.

3.5X

San Antonio residents without a high school diploma or higher education degree are 3.5 times more likely to live in poverty than peers with a diploma or degree.

The Need

According to the SA2020's latest Impact Report, college enrollment is decreasing. The urgency and need for college access services has never been greater.

In San Antonio, 35% of residents hold a college degree, compared to the national average of 47%. Of residents 25 and older, 23% have completed some college hours, but have not yet attained a degree.

This is where SAEP steps in.

Our Story

San Antonio Education Partnership (SAEP) was founded in 1989 by community leaders to bridge the gap between high school graduation, college, and career. SAEP provides students, no matter their place in life, the opportunity to access higher education through four programs: cafécollege, Road to Success, SAEP Scholarship, and Upgrade.

36 Bexar County High Schools have an SAEP college advisor on their campus serving students with one-on-one college access support and guidance.

72% of students SAEP serves are first generation college students.
