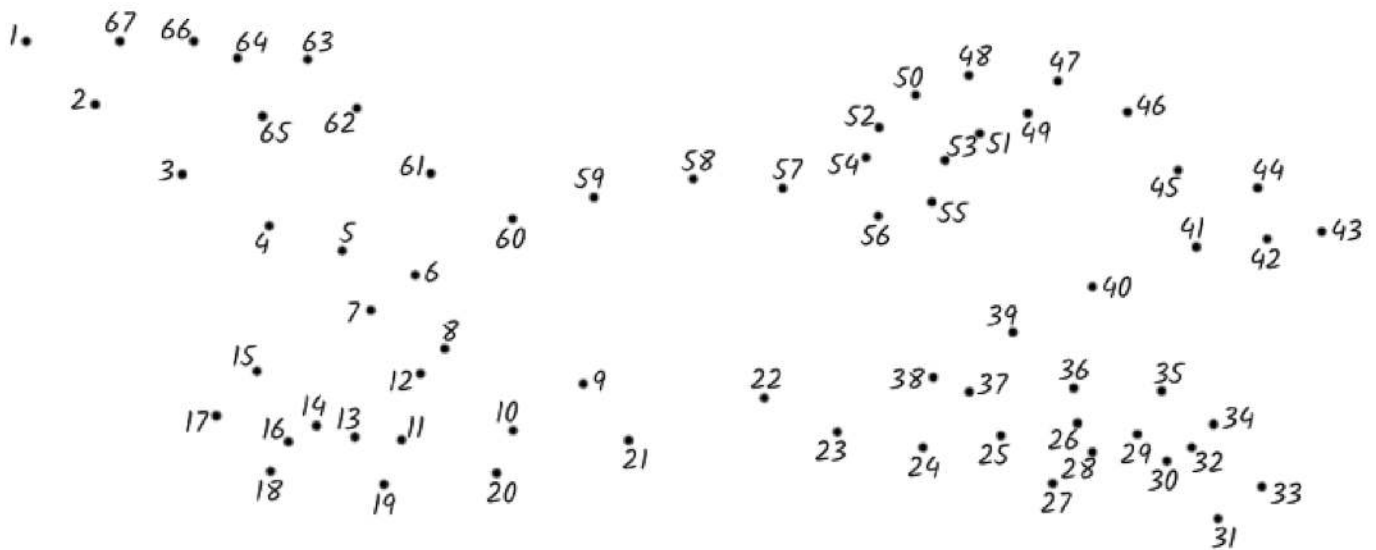


Northeast Lakeview College's mascot is Nico the Nighthawk. The school colors are green and blue. Color Nico in with the school colors!

Fans create the roadrunner hand sign by curling their middle three fingers down, leaving their thumb & pinky standing up!

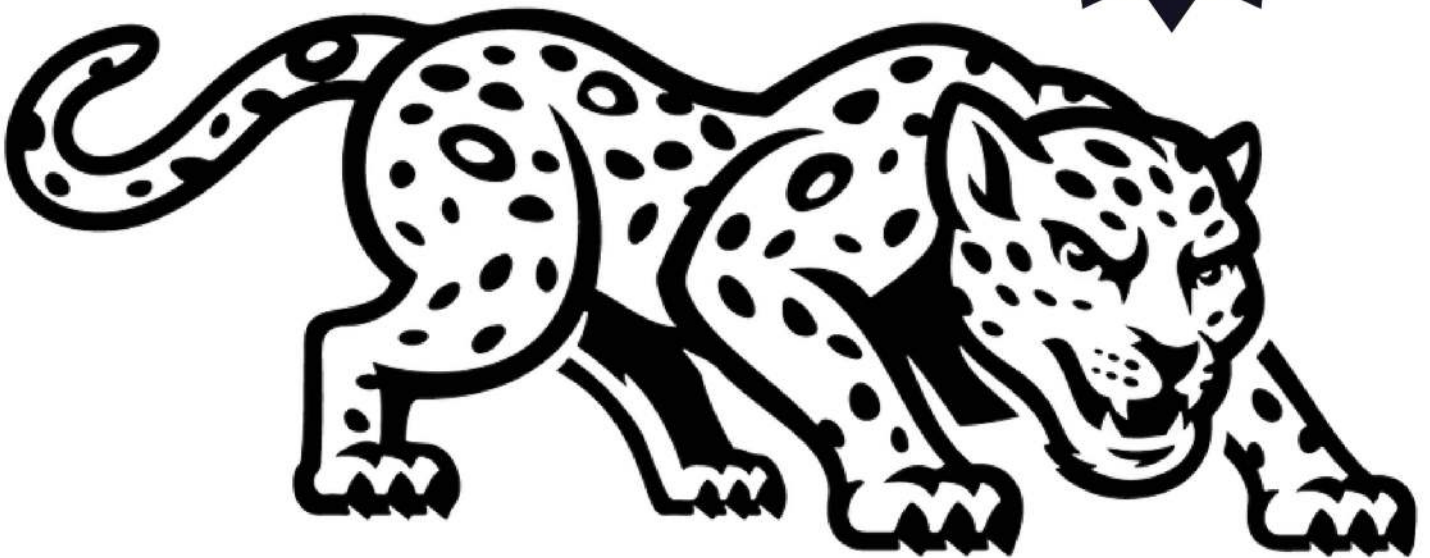




TEXAS A&M UNIVERSITY SAN ANTONIO

your palms!

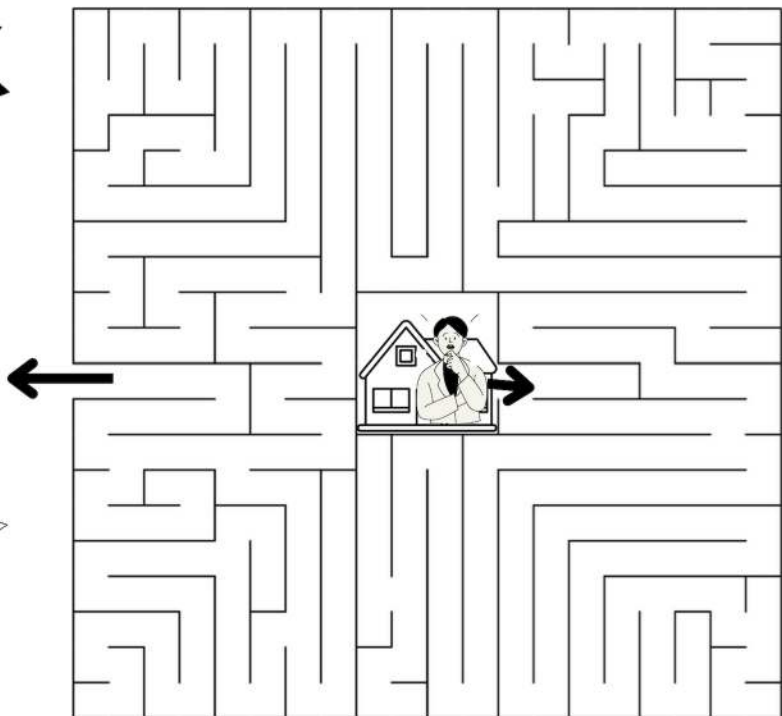




OUR LADY OF THE LAKE UNIVERSITY

Many students enjoy studying while watching the wildlife!



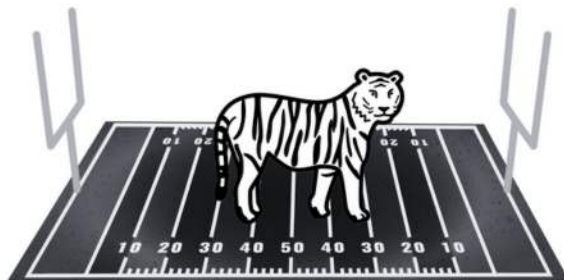


TRINITY UNIVERSITY

Lee Roy the Tiger is the mascot at Trinity University. Trinity's school colors are white and maroon! Color Lee Roy in with the school colors!



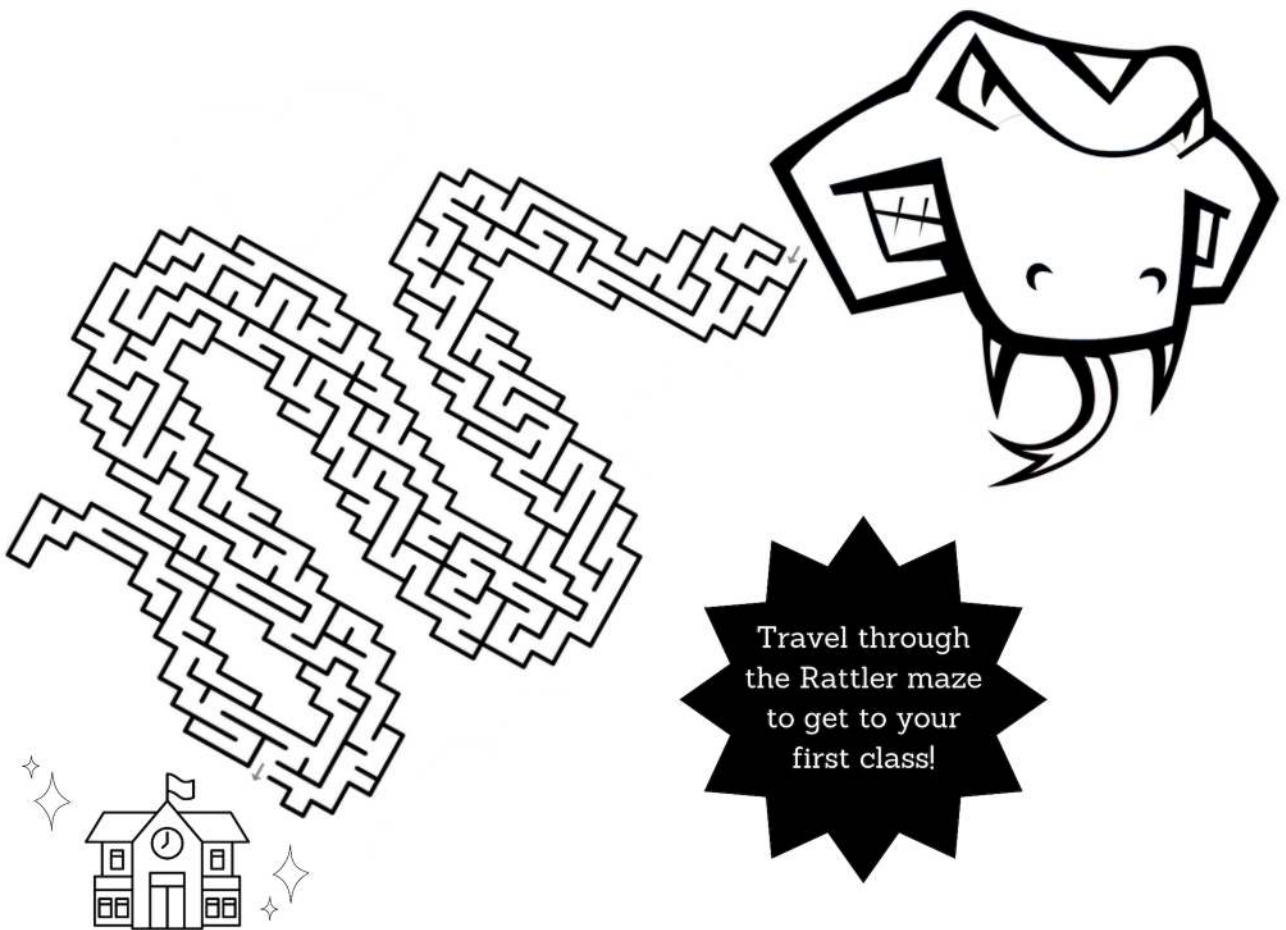
In the 1950s, Trinity University had a real tiger named Lee Roy that would visit pep rallies, games, & the school campus!

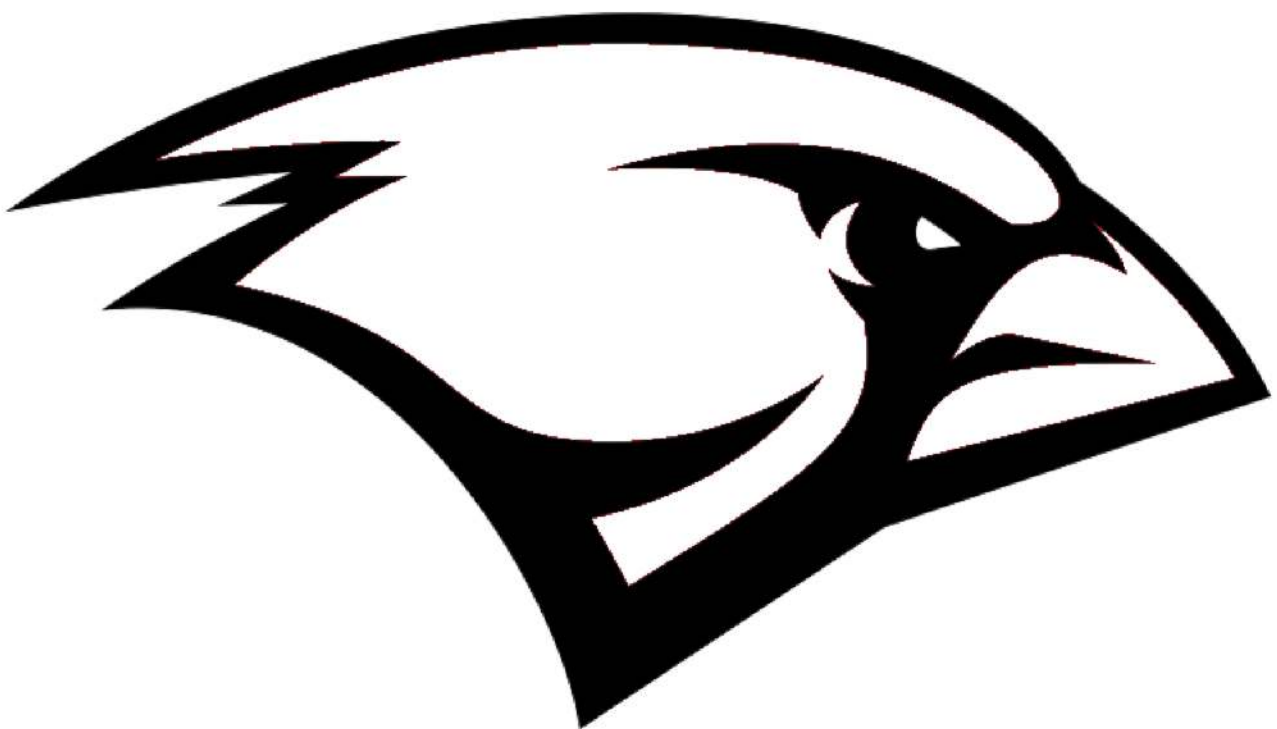
Fans show their spirit by shouting "fangs out!" Stick your "fangs out" by curling your index & middle fingers toward your palm!

The mascot at the University of the Incarnate Word are the Cardinals. The school colors are black and red. Color the Cardinal with UIW's school colors!

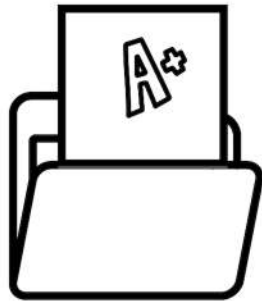


Fans show their spirit by creating the Cardinal sign! It is like the "OK" sign but your thumb & index finger are pinched together.
