


Fueling Economic Mobility

Since 1989, San Antonio Education Partnership (SAEP) has been on a mission to create college opportunities, access, and success for San Antonio students.

Education is one of the strongest predictors of long-term economic stability. Yet in San Antonio, too many students face barriers to accessing and completing college, resulting in lower degree attainment and fewer pathways to well-paying careers.

San Antonio is among the cities ranked highest in poverty, and the lowest in educational attainment.



Increasing educational attainment is key to alleviating poverty and promoting economic mobility within our community.

Educational attainment has the power to transform more than just individual lives—it uplifts entire communities by strengthening our workforce, fueling economic growth, and expanding opportunity across San Antonio.

The Heart of Our Purpose

SAEP believes every student deserves the opportunity to earn a degree or credential, no matter their background. We work to remove the barriers that often stand in their way—especially for first-generation college goers, low-income students, and students of color—ensuring equitable access to and success in higher education.

Through free personalized advising, scholarship awards, and college access and success resources, we equip students with the guidance and tools they need to achieve their educational and career goals.
